MARRIAGES:

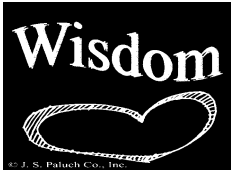
Parishioners arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the ceremony and before arranging the social plans.

Listening to today's First Reading, from Kings I, we may find ourselves humbled by Solomon's request. Given the chance to present his heart's desire to God, Solomon sought an "understanding heart" and his request was granted. Those whose hearts are filled with understanding are able to discern the treasure that is the kingdom of heaven and know to pursue it.

In our Second Reading, Paul's words are best understood when read within the context of the verses before and after them. The surrounding verses lead us to understand God's goodness and generosity.

The parables in today's reading from Matthew are also about choices and whether we have the discernment to choose wisely. Such choices, according to these parables (stories) may involve the giving up of other valuables and often incur sobering consequences.
