From Fr. Peter's Desk
21st Sunday In Ordinary Time

Dear Parish Family:



In our First Reading from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah, we learn of what St. Paul talks about in his Letter to the Romans: Our God works in unpredictable ways. This unpredictability, however, is related to God's faithful commitment to humanity. God often improvises to achieve the purpose save all. God will not give up on the first-chosen Jews, so God will likewise not give up on us when we fail.

St. Paul carries on the message from Isaiah in explaining that we cannot presume to know God's ways, or assume that God works by our expectation or calculation. We cannot dictate how God works, but we can trust God's love and the ultimate achievement of God's purpose.

In today's Gospel reading, we are shown that authority is given as a gift from God for the good of all. After Peter's confession of faith, Jesus announces that the Apostle is the rock on which the Church will be built and promises him the keys to the kingdom of heaven. God entrusts both Church and civic leaders with authority so that they may serve others in love.

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, lest we need to be reminded, we are the Church, the universal assembly of believers, the Body of Christ, called to build the kingdom of God. Let us reflect on this awesome privilege of being a part of a two thousand year old mission and contemplate on what we are called to do to bring it closer to perfection.
