From Fr. Peter's Desk
19th Sunday In Ordinary Time

Dear Parish Family:



In our First Reading from the Book of Kings, Elijah expects the Lord to come in the wind, in an earthquake or with fire. Instead, Elijah discovers the Lord in a tiny whispering sound. The Lord appears to us in many ways; are we listening for Him?

St. Paul, in our Second Reading today, is so selfless that he would sacrifice his own salvation for the sake of the salvation of Israel, "my kindred". We can imagine going to great lengths for our own family but to Paul, his family includes an entire people.

In our Gospel today, we see Jesus' faithful determination to save. Although the disciples mistook Him as a ghost and Peter doubted, Jesus walks on the stormy sea to join them and reaches out to save a sinking Peter. My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, God meets us in the most unexpected places, sometimes with a tiny whisper as He did with Elijah or sometimes in the midst of our own storm-tossed sea. When we find ourselves in deserted places, we seek to have the courage to meet the Lord in whatever way He appears and allow ourselves to be transformed. Do we have the courage to place our trust in the Lord?
