**From Fr. Peter's Desk
Fourth Sunday of Advent**

Dear Parish Family:



Our First Reading today from 2Samuel is one of the best known texts from the historical books of the Old Testament. It tells of David's desire to build a house for the Lord but God has something else in mind. God will establish a dynasty for David and at the heart of this passage is the faithfulness of God and God's word.

Paul's letter to the Romans has three verses that remind us what we well know: human beings cannot understand the ways in which God works within human history. The mystery of God is revealed in the person of Jesus, the one whose mystery we ponder this season.

In our Gospel reading from St. Luke, we focus on Mary's response to the announcement that she will give birth to a son and name him Jesus and that He will be recognized as "Son of the Most High". The Lord God will give him (Jesus) the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, a kingdom with no end.

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, throughout the ages, Mary's profound act of faith has both amazed and inspired humanity. She needs a little convincing from an Angel but in the end, her faith has its roots not in her strength but in God's. Let us pray for true faith in our own lives knowing that it will not do away with all of our fears but rather will provide us with an unwavering foundation.
