The First Reading from the Prophet Isaiah is often referred to as the opening of the "book of consolation," a work attributed to a prophet who ministered near the end of the exile in Babylon. The prophets announcement of the return of the exiles to Jerusalem, under the tender care of a loving God, was just what the people needed for their journey home.

In today's Second Reading from 2Peter, we might become confused since it addresses several related concerns. Our focus would be best directed on how we live each day while patiently awaiting the Lord's coming. Although we do not know when, we do know that the coming has been promised, and God is faithful.

Our Gospel reading introduces us to John the Baptist, the Prophet who is the bridge between the Old and New Testaments. In upcoming Gospels, John will prepare us for the arrival of Jesus.

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Advent is a season of preparation and today's readings emphasize our need to prepare for the Lord's coming. As we "prepare the way of the Lord", let the word of God open our hearts and minds for his coming to us this Christmas.
