The Epiphany of The Lord**



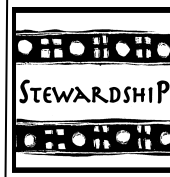
Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah, we hear rousing words addressed to the city of Jerusalem, the holy city, not to either a prophet or the people. Commentators agree that this portion of Isaiah focuses on the role of Jerusalem, the soon-to-be-restored city, where God's glory will be made manifest.

Today's versus of what is known as the "infancy narrative" of St. Matthew's Gospel is frequently identified as "the adoration of the Magi". In this section, the word Bethlehem, the place of Jesus' birth, appears four times in twelve verses. We might consider this town, this earthly place, a specific location at a given time in human history, where Jesus, son of David and Son of God, is made manifest in human flesh.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, humanity is compelled to seek the animating light that shines over all, to seek God above all things. Oneness with God is the purpose of our earthly life; we are seeking for what we believe, for what we desire: the kingdom of heaven. That light over the little town of Bethlehem has revealed the light of the world to all the nations!
